Bailey Clark,

I am going to include all three of your appeals in one response. You mention *Under Lock and Key* Nos. 30, 32 and 33.

First let me explain our impoundment process. When an institution finds something they feel needs to be impounded, they do so and post the notice on an internal bulletin board. Each institution checks this list daily and then impounds the same material for their institution until it is resolved by the Literature Review Committee.

These institutions send notice to the inmates at their own institution, notice to the publisher is only sent by the institution initiating the impoundment. You, as the publisher, will only hear from the one institution.

Issue No. 30 was initially impounded at Franklin Correctional Institution. Therefore, the Polk Correctional Institution would not notify you – only the inmate at their institution. According to their impoundment notice, Franklin CI notified you on February 18, 2013 that this issue had been impounded. A copy of the impoundment notice is attached.

Issue No. 32 was initially impounded at Florida State Prison. The impoundment notice says that notification was sent on June 3, 2013. I have attached a copy of the impoundment notice. The notice gives more specific information as to the reasons it was impounded.

Issue No. 33 was initially impounded at Florida State Prison. Therefore the Lake Correctional Institution would have only notified the inmate at Lake CI as it was Florida State Prison's responsibility to notify you, the publisher. According to the impoundment notice, FSP sent notice to you of the impoundment on August 15, 2013.

I hope this answers all of your questions. Please feel free to notify the Literature Review Committee if other questions come up.
