- 2. I seek further review, to ensure that: IPRC's denial is not arbitrary/capricious; §3.E.2.g. is being adhered to; as well as guarding against any First Amendment violations.
- 3. IPRC's denial is vague. They do "not" quote any of the narrative, that may give the inmate any insight or detail, which might help him to: accurately base an appeal, formulate a decision to appeal, and/or forgo an appeal. [See: Attachment 3-C.]
