Part A - Inmate Grievance

This is a Request for Administrative Remedy - Regarding the impoundment of Under Lock and Key - July/August 2014 #39 - on 8-18-14 - from MIM Distributors - P.O. Box 40799 - San Francisco, Ca 94140 - The Rationale for impoundment is overly broad and vague - To withstand scrutiny - The Advocacy of lawful and legal means to address the concerns of prisoners with regard to the conditions of confinement or the treatment they are accorded therein - cannot be considered disruptive or cause for censorship.

If so then the United States Constitution and the Constitution of Florida - will be considered subversive under the criteria of the Florida Department of Corrections.

There is nothing ~~more~~ that an authoritarian tyranny fears more than an informed and knowledgeable populace - who exercises their rights under the laws governing them - and not the whim and caprice of abuse and misuse of discretionary and statutory authority as evident in the customs and policies of the Department.

Disagreement with a political stance of the publishing agency is not cause for censorship - Not under the laws of this country and state.

Wherefore, I request that issue #39 of Under Lock and Key impoundment be rescinded and the issue delivered to me.
