RE: Your appeal dated January 12, 2015 regarding the rejection of Under Lock & Key No. 41

When this impounded issue arrived for review, I took it to our Security Threat Group team for evaluation. Their recommendation was this issue should not be allowed in Florida Department of Corrections facilities. The Literature Review Committee voted to follow their recommendation. After receiving your appeal, the LRC voted again to follow the STG team's recommendation. Issue 41 of Under Lock & Key will not be available for inmate use.

RE: Your letter dated January 22, 2015 regarding failure to notify publisher

In this letter, you stated that Mrs. Hughes explained in 2013 correspondence with your colleague [REDACTED] that publishers will only be notified by the first institution to impound a publication. Then you itemized 3 issues of Under Lock & Key (39, 40, and 41).

Issue 39 – mailed to [REDACTED] at Suwannee CI  
Issue 39 was initially impounded at Taylor CI and notification was mailed to MIM Distributors on August 19, 2014. No additional notification is required.

Issue 40 – mailed to [REDACTED] at Dade CI and [REDACTED] at Suwannee CI  
Issue 40 was not impounded by any facility in Florida Department of Corrections. I checked with Dade and Suwannee but neither have record of impounding this issue. Literature Review Committee records show no impoundment or review of this issue.

Issue 41 – mailed to [REDACTED] at Dade CI.  
Issue 41 was initially impounded at Florida State Prison and notification was mailed to MIM Distributors on December 24, 2014. No additional notification is required. MIM Distributors received notification from FSP as detailed in the appeal you filed – see above.
