CCE's Recommendation:	Dismissed The inmate claims Under Lock & Key newsletters were sent to CCI but were never delivered to the inmate and the inmate never received notice of non-delivery of either item. The inmate submitted a document allegedly from the publisher, asserting the item (Issue #50) had been sent to CCI and that another would be sent because the inmate had not received the first. It cannot be confirmed whether the document came from the publisher or if it is fabricated. The correspondence could have been easily produced by a person not affiliated with the company. There is nothing to confirm it is official correspondence from the publisher. Thus, the ICE and this examiner cannot give the correspondence the weight the inmate believes it deserves because the legitimacy of the document is in question. The inmate claims having never received any issue #50 of Under Lock & Key. The ICE correctly noted the item had been denied for distribution to all inmates due to content. It is unknown whether or why any issue of #50 had not been processed at CCI for this inmate. There is no record of the item(s) arriving at CCI for processing. As noted by the ICE, numerous inmates at CCI were denied the issue with notices of non-delivery issued. There is no reason this inmate's issue(s) would have been treated differently than the issues processed for other inmates. There simply isn't enough evidence to support the inmate's claim of the issue(s) not being delivered and not being documented for the inmate as not being delivered. For this reason it is recommended this appeal be dismissed. The ICE also noted in the institution's response that this inmate is not allowed to seek publication of any writing in any issue of Under Lock & Key without permission of the institution.
