FINDINGS:

On 12/16/08, the Mail Unit processed a publication "Torture US Prisons- A Belief in the worth of all people" addressed to [redacted] that was returned by UI. American Friends Newark, NJ, had sent this publication. It was denied because [redacted] was housed in Intensive Management. (Inmate Mail File – Denial #50952; FDr03/03.07)

On 12/29/08, the Mail Unit processed a publication (unable to determine publish date or title) addressed to [redacted] that was returned by UI. Prison Legal News Seattle, WA, had sent this publication. It was denied because [redacted] was housed in Intensive Management. (Inmate Mail File – Denial #54783; FDr03/03.07)

On 12/30/08, the Mail Unit processed a publication (unable to determine publish date or title) addressed to [redacted] that was returned by UI. Chicago ABC Chicago, IL, had sent this publication. It was denied because [redacted] was housed in Intensive Management. (Inmate Mail File – Denial #59812; FDr03/03.07)

CONCLUSIONS:

Intensive Management inmates shall not be permitted to receive magazines or pamphlets. The Mail Unit acted correctly by denying [redacted]'S publication while he was housed in Intensive Management. (Publications do not qualify for privileged mail treatment. FDr03/08) [redacted] will be allowed to receive acceptable publications/subscriptions when he is no longer housed in Intensive Management.

The Mail Unit will continue to process inmate mail according to policy.
