On 4/2/17, @ 10:50pm, I received from Sgt. Castrejon (this 802 is NOT on Castrejon - I input his name merely to detail the description of the issue) a letter (headed "Unconfirmed Mail Form") from MIM Distribution, dated 3/27/17. It states they sent me mail which ADC staff did not deliver to me, including: Under Lock & Key issue 55, sent 4/3/17; ULK 54, sent 2/6/17; ULK 53, sent 12/5/16; ULK 52, sent 10/10/16; and a letter, sent 10/1/16. (I am within time frames b/c I learned of this on 4/2/17.) MailRoom did not inform me these mailings were excluded or rejected; I received no 914-6 Notice or 909-6. Further, I predict you will state MailRoom advised you incoming issues are being returned to sender. But that return-to-sender order was not in effect during the majority of these mailings.

I want an explanation as to why these mailings were returned w/o informing me and \$100.00 for each mailing returned, for constitutional injuries. Also issue me my mail, listed above.
