If the offender is without funds, refuses to pay the required postage, or refuses to designate an individual to receive the property, such items shall be donated to a charitable organization or destroyed per WAC 137-36.

The offender and the sender shall be advised in writing of their right to seek review of the decision to restrict their mail. The review shall be sought by writing to the facility Superintendent/Field Administrator within 10 calendar days of the restriction decision. Please include a copy of this mail restriction notice.

If the offender on/ or sender wishes to seek a review of the Superintendent's decision, the review shall be sought by writing directly to the OCO Deputy Secretary within 10 calendar days of the decision.
