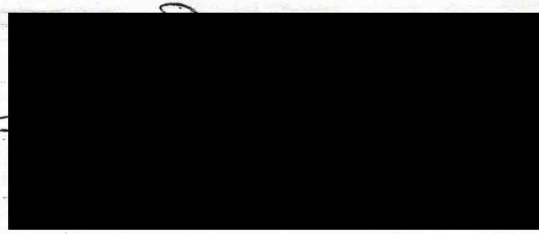

I Just Received a letter from EPS - Who Claims they Sent My Catalogs (3) on 9/3/13

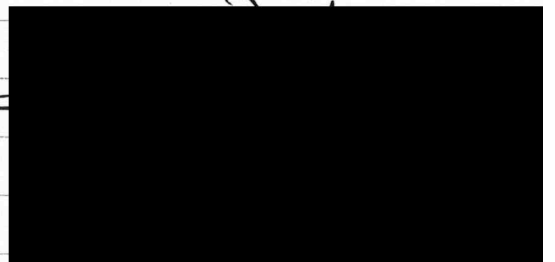
I Never Received Anything

Response of IGRC: Mail is processed daily and forwarded to its destination whether it be the post office or to the inmates on the blocks. A log is not kept for incoming or outgoing correspondence. Incoming mail is picked up at the Post Office Monday through Friday. all mail is received in the correspondence office is processed and sent to the housing units for distribution. No mail is held in the correspondence office. All mail is processed in accordance with directive #4421 and #4422, and all facility. It is the policy of the Department of corrections to neither confirm or deny the existence of a mail watch due to the safety and security concerns.

I Asked that someone from grievance come & see the letters from EPS etc. of what I didnt receive & ask that my grievance be investigated properly so that I can get relief
