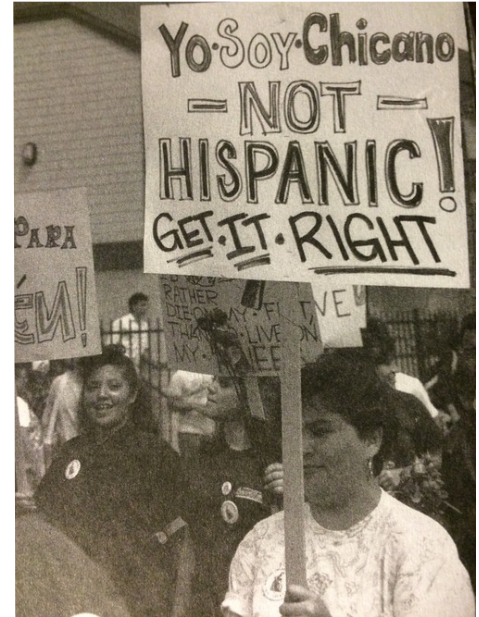


# Commemorate the Plan de San Diego Build for the Reunification and Liberation of Aztlán!

## *What was the Plan de San Diego?*

The Plan de San Diego was a revolutionary nationalist movement led by Chican@s who tried to liberate Aztlán (the southwest) from U.S. imperialism. The Plan de San Diego consisted of various classes from within the Chican@ nation who led a revolutionary-guerilla war to establish a free Chican@ state independent of Amerikkkan imperialism. This revolutionary upsurge was the inevitable result of 70 years of Amerikkkan oppression and racism in which Chican@s saw their home invaded, their lands stolen, their rights trampled on and their dignity taken away. The plan called for a liberation army that included New Afrikans and Japanese and strove for the return of land to indigenous nations.



*What's this gotta do with me? Everything you're talking about happened a long time ago. Besides, we're making progress now.*

It has everything to do with you! It has everything to do with all of us! As Chican@s growing up in occupied Aztlán, we are all familiar with what most people sometimes call racism, but which we know to be national oppression. National oppression is the term we use to describe what goes on when one nation, like say Amerikkka, oppresses another, like say Aztlán. Because we are an oppressed nation and are subjected to a distinct form of colonialism, which we refer to as semi-colonialism, it means that Amerikkkan imperialism currently dictates and controls our destiny. This is why Chican@s and other Raza are discriminated against, marginalized and imprisoned at higher rates than Amerikkkans.

This is simple revolutionary practice which everyone can engage in and in doing so will begin to challenge the Amerikkkan power structure. Here are some examples of how you can make a difference:

1. Engage Raza on the topics of the Chican@ nation and Aztlán liberation. Distribute copies of this flier and raise Raza's level of political consciousness around this issue.
2. Make a personal commitment to read one book about Chican@ liberation for the month of August. If you can read more than that, then do it! Educate yourself about Chican@ struggles in occupied Aztlán! Educate others.
3. Order Chican@ Power and the Struggle for Aztlán from MIM(Prisons) and start your own study group at your location. Then sum up your experience and send a report to Under Lock & Key. If you're studying alone, then answer the study group questions and send them in to MIM(Prisons) for review.
4. Write and submit political articles from a revolutionary perspective on topics relevant to Chican@s.
5. Draw and submit Chican@ art with strong political content to ULK for possible feature in ULK and MIM(Prisons)'s website: [prisoncensorship.info](http://prisoncensorship.info). Contribute to the new wave of Aztlán realism!
6. If you're in California, submit your thoughts, ideas and criticisms of the Agreement to End Hostilities in California Prisons. How can it be improved? In what way does it fail to meet the needs of prisoners, in particular Raza? Or is it fine just the way it is?
7. If you need somewhere you can coordinate peaceful events that will help all Raza come together across divided lines, then do it! This can only help to build Raza solidarity in general and the Chican@ movement in particular.
8. Donate stamps and/or money to MIM(Prisons). As real revolutionary internationalists, there is no other non-Chican@ organization out there that is currently doing more for the Chican@ struggle than MIM(Prisons).
